Everyone's Welcome– The programs that we offer are open to anyone that would like to participate, regardless of ability, experience, race, gender, or sexual orientation.

Employment Opportunities- Anyone interested in part-time or seasonal employment with the Portage Park & Recreation Department should visit our website, or contact our department for information about open positions.

You Snooze....You Lose- Nothing kills a program quicker than waiting until the last minute to register. If we do not meet the minimum number of participants by the registration deadline, the program will be canceled. We also set registration maximums for each program based on staff, equipment, and space, so be sure to register early in order to reserve your spot before they are all gone!

Say 'Cheese'- For program promotional purposes, photographs may be taken of participants. If you do not wish to have your photo, or photos of your children taken, please notify our department.

Residents vs. Non-Residents – All program and park shelter rentals will list 2 prices under the description. (example-\$15/\$25). The first price is for residents of the City of Portage or Pacific Township. The second price is for non-residents (Lewiston, Caledonia, Fort Winnebago, Pardeeville, etc.). Non-resident fees are charged to help our department continue to maintain our programs and facilities.

Scholarships – The City of Portage wishes to offer our programs and activities to all area children. If financial assistance is needed for a child's participation, please contact our department for more information. Park Shelter Rentals and select programs do not qualify for our scholarship program.

Typos/Mistakes— Occasionally, there may be an error in days, times, registration requirements, pricing, or location in our program descriptions. When such errors occur, our staff will do everything possible to correct the situation promptly. Our department reserves the right to change program schedules as needed to accommodate demand or school/community conflicts.

Program Refund Policy– Refunds will be granted if requests are made seven (7) days prior to the scheduled start of the activity. Please contact our department if you have questions regarding refunds due to medical or unavoidable circumstances. All refunds carry a \$5.00 processing fee.

Facility Rental Refund Policy– Refunds for facility rentals will be granted if requests are made thirty (30) days prior to scheduled rental. Extenuating circumstances are occasionally considered. All refunds carry a \$10.00 processing fee.



PARK PROJECT UPDATE

NEW PARK & RECREATION BUILDING

The City of Portage has begun construction on our NEW shared facility for the Parks/Recreation Department and Public Works Department. This facility is located at 401 Cemetery Road and is expected to be finished and operational by summer 2025. This new facility will benefit the community and our departments by providing sufficient vehicle and equipment storage, modernized mechanic and office workstations, and allow us to better collaborate on city projects by being under one roof.

We are extremely excited for this addition to the city and one feature that we are especially thrilled about is the Community Room. This Community Room will provide us a new space for all of our current indoor programs, and also give us our own space to create and offer new programs and classes in the future!

PLAYGROUND AT PINE MEADOW PARK

Construction will begin this fall on a new playground at Pine Meadow Park!





CANOE/KAYAK LAUNCH

We have added an accessible Canoe/Kayak Launch at our Highway 33 Wayside park, located just east of Portage along the Fox River. This launch has a paved path from the parking lot and is free to use!



POCKET PARK

Construction is ongoing at our new 'Pocket Park' located downtown at the intersection of Wisconsin St and Dewitt St. This park will feature benches, picnic tables, and is located on the Ice Age Trail that passes through the heart of Portage. This project was completely funded through grants and donations.



Fall Clean-Up: October 5th, 2024, 8:00a.m. – 2:00p.m. at the Public Works Garage located at 616 Washington Street.

Guidelines for Brush Collection: Remaining Brush Collection will take place September 9th, October 7th, and November 4th. Brush needs to be out in your boulevard by 6am Monday morning to be picked up that week. Leaf and grass clipping bags must be separated from the brush and be out by 6am Monday morning as well. Leaf and grass bags may be collected separately from our brush collection.

Waste Water Reminders: If you have a sanitary back-up after 4:30pm Monday-Friday, or on a Saturday, Sunday, or a holiday, please call 608-742-2171.

Recycling: Columbia County Recycling is the City of Portage's contractor for garbage and recycling collection. Please visit our City website for information on what can and can't be recycled at https://www.portagewi.gov/garbage-and-recycling/. Additionally, the City maintains a drop off center for residents to use for household recyclables as a supplement to curbside collection on Washington Street. Please note, this drop off site is monitored by video surveillance to ensure drop off guidelines are followed. Guidelines for drop off are posted on-site.

Water Utility: Crews will be performing fall hydrant flushing between September 9th, 2024 and October 26th, 2024. If you experience any discoloration in your water during this time, simply run your faucet with cold water until the water clears.

Remaining 2024 Construction/Improvement Projects Updates

E. Slifer Street Reconstruction: Paving work associated with the E. Slifer Street portion of the project will take place beginning August 16th, 2024 and continue through August 23rd, 2024. During paving operations E. Slifer Street will remain completely closed for the entirety of the day hot mix asphalt is placed until the asphalt has cooled. Following pavement placement, crews will work to restore the disturbed boulevards as well as replace the pavement markings. Work on E. Slifer is expected to be completed by August 29th, 2024. The Woodcrest portion of the project is scheduled to be complete mid-late September. Work remaining will consist of restoration of boulevards and chip sealing of the disturbed roadway segments.
