Everyone's Welcome– The programs that we offer are open to anyone that would like to participate, regardless of ability, experience, race, gender, or sexual orientation.

Employment Opportunities- Anyone interested in part-time or seasonal employment with the Portage Park & Recreation Department should visit our website, or contact our department for information about open positions.

You Snooze....You Lose- Nothing kills a program quicker than waiting until the last minute to register. If we do not meet the minimum number of participants by the registration deadline, the program will be cancelled. We also set registration maximums on each program based on staff, equipment, and space, so be sure to register early in order to reserve your spot before they are all gone!

Say 'Cheese'- For program promotional purposes, photographs may be taken of participants. If you do not wish to have your photo, or photos of your children taken, please notify our department.

Residents vs. Non-Residents – All program and park shelter rentals will list 2 prices under the description. (example- \$15/\$25). The first price is for residents of the City of Portage or Pacific Township. The second price is for non-residents (Lewiston, Caledonia, Fort Winnebago, Pardeeville, etc.). Non-resident fees are charged to help our department continue to maintain our programs and facilities.

Scholarships – The City of Portage wishes to offer our programs and activities to all area children. If financial assistance is needed for a child's participation, please contact our department for more information. Park Shelter Rentals and select programs do not qualify for our scholarship program.

Typos/Mistakes– Occasionally, there may be an error in days, times, registration requirements, pricing, or location in our program descriptions. When such errors occur, our staff will do everything possible to correct the situation promptly. Our department reserves the right to change program schedules as needed to accommodate demand or school/community conflicts.

Program Refund Policy– Refunds will be granted if requests are made seven (7) days prior to the scheduled start of the activity. Please contact our department if you have questions regarding refunds due to medical or unavoidable circumstances. All refunds carry a \$5.00 processing fee.

Facility Rental Refund Policy– Refunds for facility rentals will be granted if requests are made thirty (30) days prior to scheduled rental. Extenuating circumstances are occasionally considered. All refunds carry a \$10.00 processing fee.



<u>Karate</u>

Karate Basics

This class is for ages 6+ who are at the introductory level of karate. Participants will learn martial arts fundamentals and a strong emphasis will be put on building confidence, focus, discipline, and respect. Each student will have the opportunity to test at the end of the session. This program is for participants with less than a green belt status.

Karate Advanced

This program is a step above our Karate Basics program, and will teach advanced karate skills to ages 6+. Participants in this program must be a green belt or higher to participate in this class.


Youth Basketball Teams



New Ball Field at the Fairgrounds

Construction on the 2nd ball field at the Fairgrounds is underway. This will be a multi-use field and will host our Adult Softball games, Youth T-Ball Programs, Masters Baseball Program, as well as our Youth Flag Football utilizing the outfield grass in the spring and fall. This field will also be available for local teams as a practice site, and we hope to host youth softball, youth baseball, and adult softball tournaments in the near future!

Playground Improvements at Collipp-Worden Park & Pauquette Park

We've added some great new features to our 2 busiest parks! At Collipp-Worden Park, we have added an ADA compliant border around the entire playground, as well as new concrete around the shelter and path from the parking lot. We added a new swing bay with a combination of toddler swings and regular swings. The most popular improvement to that park has been the installation of a zipline in the playground!



At Pauquette Park, we removed the old, outdated swing bay and installed a new swing bay off the corner of the existing playground area. This new swing bay included 2 regular swings and 1 toddler swing.



We also completed work on the Beasley Pavilion, which is now open and available for rentals. So if you're planning any graduation parties, weddings receptions, birthday parties, or family reunions for next year, be sure to check out this great new shelter, right next to the pond at Pauquette Park!
