Everyone's Welcome– The programs that we offer are open to anyone that would like to participate, regardless of ability, experience, race, gender, or sexual orientation.

Employment Opportunities- Anyone interested in part-time or seasonal employment with the Portage Park & Recreation Department should visit our website, or contact our department for information about open positions.

You Snooze....You Lose- Nothing kills a program quicker than waiting until the last minute to register. If we do not meet the minimum number of participants by the registration deadline, the program will be canceled. We also set registration maximums for each program based on staff, equipment, and space, so be sure to register early in order to reserve your spot before they are all gone!

Say 'Cheese'- For program promotional purposes, photographs may be taken of participants. If you do not wish to have your photo, or photos of your children taken, please notify our department.

Residents vs. Non-Residents– All program and park shelter rentals will list 2 prices under the description. (example- \$15/\$25). The first price is for residents of the City of Portage or Pacific Township. The second price is for non-residents (Lewiston, Caledonia, Fort Winnebago, Pardeeville, etc.). Non-resident fees are charged to help our department continue to maintain our programs and facilities.

Scholarships– The City of Portage wishes to offer our programs and activities to all area children. If financial assistance is needed for a child's participation, please contact our department for more information. Park Shelter Rentals and select programs do not qualify for our scholarship program.

Typos/Mistakes– Occasionally, there may be an error in days, times, registration requirements, pricing, or location in our program descriptions. When such errors occur, our staff will do everything possible to correct the situation promptly. Our department reserves the right to change program schedules as needed to accommodate demand or school/community conflicts.

Program Refund Policy– Refunds will be granted if requests are made seven (7) days prior to the scheduled start of the activity. Please contact our department if you have questions regarding refunds due to medical or unavoidable circumstances. All refunds carry a \$5.00 processing fee.

Facility Rental Refund Policy– Refunds for facility rentals will be granted if requests are made thirty (30) days prior to scheduled rental. Extenuating circumstances are occasionally considered. All refunds carry a \$10.00 processing fee.

KARATE

Karate Basics

This class is for ages 6+ who are at the introductory level of karate. Participants will learn martial arts fundamentals and a strong emphasis will be put on building confidence, focus, discipline, and respect. Each student will have the opportunity to test at the end of the session. This program is for participants with less than a green belt status.

Karate Intermediate

This is our mid-level karate and will help build and improve the karate participants' skills and knowledge. This program is designed for experienced karate participants and will be fun for all age levels and participants.

Karate Advanced

This program is a step above our Karate Basics program and will teach advanced karate skills to ages 6+. Participants in this program must be a green belt or higher to participate in this class.

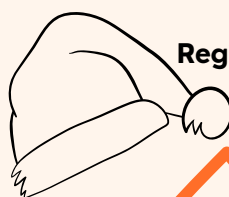
A CALL FROM SANTA

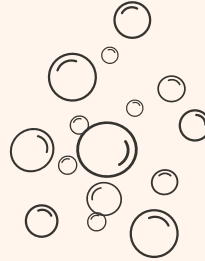

PARK PROJECT UPDATE

SKATEPARK PHASE 3

Construction on Phase III of the Portage Family Skatepark at Goodyear Park is under way! The Portage Family Skatepark organization fundraised for Phase III to add a new kidney-bowl for the intermediate and advanced skaters. Construction is expected to wrap up this Fall, with a grand re-opening tentatively scheduled for Saturday, September 24th. Be sure to follow our Facebook page for updates.



LINCOLN PARK BUILDING

The Lincoln Park Food Pantry building will be going through some rehab work on the exterior of the building to fix some cracking bricks.

PARK SHELTER ROOF UPGRADES

This fall we will be replacing the roofs on 3 of our park shelters (Collipp-Worden #1, Pauquette Park #2, and Silver Lake Beach). The metal roofs we are installing will help slow the deterioration of the shelters and increase their lifespan.

BALL FIELD UPDATE

Construction on a 2nd ball field at the Fairgrounds was completed this spring, with the first games on the new field being played during the Columbia County Fair. We are also working to remove the outdated backstops at the Little League Complex and replacing them new chain-link backstops.

PICKLEBALL COURTS

We will be resurfacing the current tennis/pickleball courts at Pine Meadow Park and installing pickleball courts with permanent nets and painted lines. We are hoping to continue offering Introduction to Pickleball programs, as well as adding pickleball leagues. This court will no longer be available for tennis use.

CITY NEWS

Fall Clean-Up: October 8, 2022 8 a.m. – 2 p.m. at the Public Works Garage located at 616 Washington St.

Guidelines for Brush Collection: Remaining Brush Collection will take place the week of August 8, September 12, October 3, and November 7. Brush needs to be out in your boulevard by **7am Monday morning** to be picked up that week. Leaf and grass clipping bags must be separated from the brush and be out by **7am Monday morning** as well. Leaf and grass bags may be collected separately from our brush collection.

Water Utility: Portage Utilities recently partnered with the Wisconsin Dept. of Natural Resources (WisDNR) to conduct voluntary sampling of the drinking water in Portage for the presence of per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS). PFAS are a group of human-made chemicals which have made their way into the environment through spills and/or discharges. Studies have indicated possible links between levels of PFAS and health effects in people. PFAS sampling was performed at several locations and the results were either undetectable (not present) or significantly below the Health Advisory Limit at all locations sampled. Therefore, at this time, the level of PFAS concentrations in the drinking water do not pose any health threat. The PFAS sample results can be found on the WisDNR website listed here:

Remaining 2022 Construction/Improvement Projects

Jefferson Street Stormwater Lift Station: Specific construction dates to be determined. The project will consist of the complete replacement of the existing stormwater lift station located in the alleyway between Carroll St and Howard St from DeWitt St to Jefferson St. The project will incorporate new pumps, controls, force main, and a wet well to improve stormwater runoff.

Portage Canal: The Wisconsin Department of Transportation will be continuing with the next phase of the Portage Canal project which will include installation of a paved pedestrian path along the canal starting at Adams St and continuing to Morgan St. The path will include bench bump outs, lighting, and signage.
