Participants MUST attend all sessions in order to receive certification

### PREREQUISITE REQUIREMENTS

- 300 yard continuous swim using freestyle and/or breast stroke
- Tread water for 2 minutes using legs only
- Swim 20 yards, dive to a depth of 11 ft., retrieve a 10 pound brick, swim back and exit water in 1 minute 40 seconds
- Complete all online assignments
  prior to in-person sessions
