The winter season we just experienced qualifies as a mild one by most definitions and our department is excited to roll out a vast range of warm weather activities as we look ahead in our community. In addition to the two playground projects, the department continues work with Rettler Corporation on designing two new softball fields which are scheduled to be constructed on the north end of the Columbia County Fairgrounds, Construction documents are over 50 % complete and following final inspections required for construction (wetland determination, soil boring reports, etc.), the City is hopeful to begin construction on this project during the summer of this year. Continue to check the parks and recreation board meetings and agendas for further updates on this project.

The team here at the Parks and Recreation Department is excited to see our busy season approach and we can't wait to see you at our parks and facilities in 2017. 
